RESOLUTION ELECTING TO RECEIVE ADDITIONAL TAX ALLOCATION  
PURSUANT TO SECTION 33676 OF THE HEALTH AND SAFETY CODE FOR THE  
CITY OF STOCKTON EASTLAND REDEVELOPMENT PROJECT

WHEREAS, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Stockton is preparing a Redevelopment Plan for the Eastland Redevelopment Project Area (the "Redevelopment Plan"), which provides for tax increment financing pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 33670 to the detriment of the San Joaquin County taxpayers; and,

WHEREAS, the County of San Joaquin is an affected taxing agency authorized to make the election described in Health and Safety Code Section 33676.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the County of San Joaquin on behalf of the County and the San Joaquin County Flood Control and Water Conservation District elects for the Eastland Redevelopment Project Area to receive allocation of taxes pursuant to Health and Safety Code Section 33676 in addition to the allocation of taxes provided for in Health and Safety Code Section 33670.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Clerk of the Board is directed to send copies of this resolution to the City of Stockton, the Redevelopment Agency of the City of Stockton, the Assessor, the Auditor-Controller, and the Treasurer-Tax Collector.
