


Bike Stockton Bikesharing Program

Downtown Moves Forward with \$5.2M Grant

Stockton received \$600,000 through an EPA Brownfields Community-wide Assessment Grant and leveraged this assessment and planning effort to successfully secure \$5.24 million in cleanup funding through the California Department of Toxic Substances Control's Equitable Community Revitalization Grant Program. Funding will be used for cleanup of a 9-acre City-owned site along Stockton's waterfront, known as South Pointe.
