(Stockton, CA) – The Stockton Arts Commission has a total of \$9,500 available for mini arts grants (up to \$1,000 each) to benefit children in the City of Stockton. Applications must be submitted no later than February 17, 2016, by 4:00 p.m. These grants are funded by Mary Muller-Niven in honor of her father and mother Alfred H. and Camilla Muller to explore, expand, introduce, and involve youth in the visual and performing arts. Art organizations, art educators, and art program leaders who reside, do business, or provide education in Stockton may apply. Grants will be awarded in March 2016.
