Accepting Applications for Stockton Arts Commission Vacancies

(Stockton, CA) - The City of Stockton is currently accepting applications for two (2) vacancies on the sixteen-member (16) Stockton Arts Commission, due to the resignation of two (2) members. Full terms are for four (4) years. The term for these appointments will expire October 31, 2012. The deadline for applications is Thursday, September 22, 2011, at 5:30 p.m.

Appointments are ratified by the City Council. Applicants must be active in arts and cultural activities; demonstrate interest or accomplishments in fund-raising and in one or more of the following disciplines: music, dance, theater, cinema, photography, architecture, art criticism, textile arts, literary arts and the visual arts, including, but not limited to, the public or environmental arts, graphic arts, design, drawing, painting, printmaking, sculpture, ceramics and art history. Applicants must reside in the city of Stockton and may not hold any public office or position of employment with the City of Stockton.
