### **City of Stockton Accepting Applications for San Joaquin County Mosquito and Vector Control District Board**

(Stockton, CA) - The City of Stockton is currently accepting applications to fill one (1) vacancy on the eleven-member San Joaquin County Mosquito and Vector Control District Board of Trustees. This vacancy is due to the term expiration of a Stockton City Council appointed member on December 31, 2011. The term of office is for four (4) years. The application deadline is Thursday, October 6, 2011 at 5:30p.

To qualify, applicants must reside in the District at least one year immediately prior to appointment to the Board, be a registered voter and a resident in the city of Stockton, and may not hold any public office or position of employment with the City of Stockton.

The function of this board is to govern the administration and operations of the Mosquito and Vector Control District, including the surveillance and control of vectors and vector-borne diseases. Recent activities of the Board include the development and implementation of procedures for the effective control of mosquitoes to reduce the spread of

The Board meets on the third Tuesday of each month at 1:00 p.m. in the District office, 7759 S. Airport Way, Stockton. The Board of Trustees provides for the allowance and payment to each trustee a sum of one-hundred dollars (\$100) per month for expenses incurred while on official business.
