City of Stockton Seeking Volunteers American Legion Park Beautification Project – Saturday, July 15th

STOCKTON, Calif. – City of Stockton Clean City Initiative is seeking volunteers to help with an American Legion Park Beautification Project on Saturday, July 15, 2023, from 8:30 –11:30 a.m., at 1859 Baker St. Volunteers are needed to help remove accumulated debris from the waterway and will meet at the flagpole. Debris removal will help prevent it from entering the water, which harms the aquatic life that is near the shore.

Bottled water, garbage bags, trash picker extenders, gardening gloves, and hand sanitizer will be provided. Volunteers are encouraged to bring a brimmed hat, sunscreen, shade glasses, and any extra tools such as rakes, ropes, water skimmer, and appropriate clothing and footwear for working near the water.
