I responded from quarters for a report of a building fire. I arrived on scene on the north side of the building. This was a fire in a commercial occupancy located (market) on the first floor with four floors above consisting of residential apartments. The fire had been knocked down prior to my arrival. I faced-to-faced with Command and was assigned Interior Division.

Inside, I met with T2 Captain on the second floor. I was advised that a primary had been completed and negative on all four upper floors. There was no fire extension found on the floors above the fire. I had E6, T2, T4 and T3 inside assisting with search for life and fire.

Later, PGE electric advised and recommended that we shut power down to the whole building due to water draining from the fire floor into the basement and onto the electrical meters and disconnects. I worked with multiple crews in notifying the occupants of this power shut down situation.

T2 arrived with fire in the store on the Acacia side. T2 spotted the N/E corner for Aerial use. T2 made sure E9 had access for Fire Attack and then went all up to D2. T2 kept 2 in D2 to check for victims and extension and sent 2 to upper floors for the same. T2 performed overhaul as well as an initial Origin/Cause.

Origin/Cause

Origin:

Because of the previous fire and the nature of this fire T2 requested Arson, SPD and FET. T2 overhauled but preserved the scene as best as possible. FET handled all pictures and SPD took witness statements.

SPD DR# 23-438

The fire Originated in the convenience store located on the Acacia side of the building. The fire at one point had what I associate with an explosion type event and blew glass and parts of the store front out into and across the street.

The front scissor gate and front man door were locked at the time of the fire. 2 people were on site in the S/W corner of the store in a make shift apartment at the time of the fire.

Undetermined pending investigation.

BC1 was dispatched with a first alarm assignment for a reported structure fire.

E9 arrived to report fire showing from the first floor business front of a 5-story taxpayer. E9 reported they were stretching a live line to the first floor business on fire.

E2 arrived to report they were securing a water supply and assisting with line placement.

E6 arrived to report they were stretching a live line to the second story apartment directly over the fire.

T2 reported they were assisting with forcible entry of the fire unit and then going all in for search on the second floor. T2 reported that residents on the second floor were being directed to exit the building and all remaining floors were being sheltered in place. T2 reported that they were opening the floor above the fire room to check for extension.

BC1 arrived and I established El Dorado Command, requesting a second alarm with the addition of T4 to the assignment.

E3 was assigned as RIC.

T3 laddered the S/E roof with their aerial and went all in for search starting on the top floor working their way down. T3 reported that the bulkhead was open, clear and that they were sheltering residents in place.

E11 was directed to report to the top floor and assist T3 with sheltering residents in place.

E4 was directed to secure utilities.

T4 was directed to report to T2 and assist with sheltering residents in place.

The fire was placed under control, primary search complete and negative with no vertical fire extension to the second floor.

SFD arson was requested with no response. SPD FET responded to document fire scene findings.

The business owner of the fire affected business was on scene and advised they were responsible for the board up.

PG&E gas and electric arrived to assess their respective utilities. The building main electrical BUSS was located directly beneath the fire room and had several previous cracks in the floor that were allowing suppression water to drain onto the BUSS. The BUSS was arcing/smoking and PG&E electric determined that they would need to cut power to the entire building.

SFD crews made contact with residents in all apartments advising that the power was going to be disconnected. We offered Red Cross to house them or advised they could remain in their apartment w/o power. By the time crews cleared the scene approximately 15 residents requested Red Cross. By approximately 0900 the following morning the number of residents requesting Red Cross increased to approximately 35.

Due to the power being disconnected and the subsequent loss of the fire alarm system I required a fire watch throughout the night. We were unable to locate a responsible party to secure the fire watch nor a private security hire back so SFD crews were rotated through the scene for the fire watch responsibility. The responsibility for fire watch was handed over to Code Enforcement at approximately 0800 hours on 1/5/2023.

Engine 9 Captain denied assistance and Engine 2 notified them that they would bounce upstairs to Div 2 to assist with operations. Engine 2 assisted Engine 6 and Truck 2 in notifying residents of the fire and checking for overhaul. Engine 2 assisted the Operator in collecting names (on the 4th) for Red Cross. Engine 2 assisted with overhaul in the fire unit. Engine 9 and Truck 2 denied any further assistance after overhaul and restoring equipment was complete. Engine 2 AOR.

E4 shut off multiple power in multiple boxes on the west side of the building, found power still on in the building. E4 made access to the basement, forcing multiple doors to find the bank of electrical shut offs for the building. Radio traffic indicated fire under control, BC1 advised E4 not to shut off power, that PG&E would isolate the power to be shut off. E4 released from the scene by BC1. No injuries report by E4 crew. AOR>
