MONTHLY PROGRESS UPDATE

Background

This monthly report is to provide a brief progress update on the multiple discretionary funded projects approved by City Council on November 16, 2021, by Resolution No. 2021-11-16-1501. Council allocated \$9.85 million in funding for various park, tree, transportation, and facility improvement projects citywide for delivery by the Public Works Department.

On May 3, 2022, by Resolution No. 2022-05-03-0903, Council allocated an additional \$10.2 million in funding for projects including sidewalk replacements, tree maintenance, and park improvements.

PROJECTS IN CONSTRUCTION

Brooking, Panella, Sandman & Weber Park Playground Replacements, Project No. WP22026

A recommendation to award Brooking, Panella, and Weber playground replacements is tentatively scheduled for the September 26 City Council meeting.

A public outreach meeting for the all-abilities playground at Sandman Park was held on August 7. The comments from the meeting are being incorporated into the final design and the award of the contract for Sandman Park is expected by December 2023.



Citywide Park Walkway Replacement, Project No. WT22015


Project includes evaluating trip hazards at multiple community park sites, such as Victory, Faklis, Weston, Sherwood, and more. Repairs were completed at Faklis, Weston, and Sherwood Parks last month. Repairs at Victory Park commence next week.





Downtown Decorative Streetlight LED Conversion, Project No. WD22016

This project is now **complete** with over 350 decorative Downtown streetlights converted to LED fixtures.






Intersection Safety Tree Trimming, Project No. WD22018

The Construction Contract was awarded at the June 20 City Council meeting. A public outreach plan is being finalized prior to the Contractor starting work in October.

Miracle Mile RRFB & Improvements, Project No. WT22052

The Construction Contract was awarded at the August 22 City Council meeting. Work is anticipated to begin in October and be completed by the end of December, weather permitting.





Pixie Woods Improvements, Project No. WP22054

Public Works and Community Services Departments met with the Pixie Woods Board in summer of 2022 to identify and prioritize improvements. Additional carousel repairs are underway with fabrication of replacement components. The custom cranks and hi hats were received (photos below) and will be installed later this September.

Sidewalk Replacements, Project No. WD22053

The tree removal component of this project was awarded a Construction Contract at the March 21 City Council meeting. The project has been suspended indefinitely.

Overall Construction Completion 60%

Swimming Pool UV Sterilization System Improvements, Project No. WP22027

Staff recommends a scope change to assess the needs of existing aquatic facilities and to prioritize improvements to better serve the needs of the community. Emergency repairs at

Brooking Pool were recently completed and staff will be ratifying the repairs before City Council for approval at the October 17 meeting.



Tree Maintenance, Project No. WE22052

The Construction Contract was awarded at the June 20 City Council meeting. A public outreach plan is being finalized prior to the Contractor starting work in October.

Van Buskirk Gym Floor Replacement, Project No. WC22003

HY Flooring began applying the AC-Tech epoxy to the gym floor last week. Photos below.

Victory Park Tennis Court Lighting Refurbishment, Project No. WP22030 Long lead material items have been ordered by the Contractor. The Contractor expects delivery of the electrical pedestal by mid-October with improvements immediately following.

Weber Point Events Center Shade Structure Rehab, Project No. WP22033 Bid opening was on August 31 and one bid was received. The bid is regular and will be recommended for approval at the November City Council meeting.

American Legion Park Lagoon Fencing Replacement, Project No. WP22036 Construction is anticipated to start in November 2023.
Overall Design Completion50%
Citywide Bridge Slope Protection, Project No. WT22039 Slope protection at Airport Way and Mormon Slough is scheduled to be complete with design early 2024 and be in construction by the following summer.
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Oak Park Senior Center Parking Lot Resurfacing, Project No. WD22012

Design is wrapping up and the project is scheduled to advertise for construction bids this month with bid opening in November. Construction is anticipated to take place in early spring 2024.

Overall Design Completion......99%

Pixie Woods Irrigation Automation, Project No. WP22038

The irrigation master plan evaluation and design are complete. The project is scheduled to advertise for construction bids in October.

Overall Design Completion......99%

Sousa Pool Crack Repair and Re-plastering, Project No. WP22040

An assessment was completed in December with final recommendations for pool improvements. Replastering will be scheduled at close of the 2023 operating season. It is recommended that a strategic plan be prepared to address the repairs needed at this facility, as well as others, to better serve the needs of the community.

Overall Design Completion......99%

Teen Impact Center Rehabilitation, Project No. CR22001

This facility is being evaluated for different operations and best uses. Economic Development will include this facility in an upcoming RFP to seek interest in City-owned sites and facilities (surplus properties) in the greater Downtown footprint.
